



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING



Between

Rajamangala University of Technology Phra Nakhon, Bangkok, Thailand

And

Fuzhou Zhiyuan Education Technology Co.,Ltd., P.R. China

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made and executed by and between Rajamangala University of Technology Phra Nakhon (RMUTP), is a public university located in Bangkok, where under the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research, and Innovation, Thailand, which located at 399 Samsen Road, Vachira Phayaban, Dusit, Bangkok, Thailand, represented by its President Dr. Natworapol Rachsirivatcharabul, duly authorized, hereinafter referred to as “RMUTP”,

and

Fuzhou Zhiyuan Education Technology Co., Ltd., is one of the top enterprises in the field of vocational education in Fujian Province, with its main office located at Suite 1101-1110, Floor 11, Sanya Building B, 216 Shangsang Road, Cangshan District, Fuzhou, Fujian, China, represented by its President, Ms. Bin Xia, duly authorized, hereinafter referred to as “Zhiyuan Education”.

1. Objective

This MOU focuses on the educational cooperation between Zhiyuan Education and RMUTP by recruiting and selecting students to participate in the RMUTP, and also organize of joint training, seminar, official visit, academic exchange, and joint research to strengthen international academic cooperation in the China-Thailand project.

2. Area of Cooperation

2.1 Educational cooperation by recruiting and selecting students to participate in the RMUTP.

2.2 Organization of joint training, seminars, official visit, and academic exchange for developing and upskilling to Chinese students.

2.3 Development of joint research activities for developing RMUTP to be international education standard.

3. Responsibilities of the Parties

3.1 Responsibilities of RMUTP

3.1.1 Provide authorization certificate for the promotion and recruiting of Zhiyuan Education.

3.1.2 Provide standard terms and conditions of prospective students for recruitment and registration of Chinese students (according to the rules and regulations of RMUTP) and issue the letter of acceptance of Chinese students.

3.1.3 Provide standard terms and conditions of graduation for Chinese students (according to the rules and regulations of RMUTP) and issue certificate of graduation of Chinese students.

3.1.4 In order to Chinese students' recruitment and supervision, RMUTP may delegate the relevant faculty or college to cooperate with Zhiyuan Education (according to the rules and regulations of RMUTP) and courses provided to Chinese students should not involve negative content such as Chinese politics.

3.1.5 Issue tuition fees receipt of RMUTP which were collected from Chinese students to Zhiyuan Education.

3.1.6 Provide support which relates to academic cooperation with the relevant departments.

3.2 Responsibilities of Zhiyuan Education

3.2.1 As the authorized representative of the China region (including Hong Kong, Macao, and Taiwan) of RMUTP, Zhiyuan Education is fully responsible for the promotion of RMUTP's curriculum.

3.2.2 Responsible for reviewing, selecting, and verifying the qualifications of Chinese students according to the rules and regulations of RMUTP.

3.2.3 Cooperate teaching activities with RMUTP or delegated faculty including trainings, seminars, official visit, and academic exchange and assign translators or interpreters for courses which were taught in Thai and English, meetings with RMUTP or delegated faculty, Thesis defense, and advisor/lecturer introduction who teach in Chinese.

3.2.4 Manage Chinese students including consultancy, assistance, registration documents, health insurance, visa application, rules and regulatory compliance of RMUTP, registration and enrollment, daily life in Thailand, physical and mental healthcare, accommodation, extracurricular activities, and others for a well-being of Chinese students until graduation.

3.2.5 Proceed with the payment of tuition fees from Chinese students to RMUTP according to the specified rate of tuition fees of international students.

3.2.6 Responsible for employee costs incurred by Zhiyuan Education for publicity and promotion, travel reception, daily management, and knowledge source education.

3.2.7 Appoint a dedicated person to coordinate with RMUTP or delegated faculty or college to follow up teaching and graduation procedures of Chinese students.

3.2.8 Provide support which relates to academic cooperation to the relevant departments.

4. Expenditures and Budgetary

Any expenditures which may incurred under section 2 Area of Cooperation (2.1 – 2.3) must comply with the Rules of Thailand's Ministry of Finance on the Expenditures of International Training, Events, and Conferences or Revenue and Expenditures Guidance of RMUTP

5. Effect of Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding serves only as a record of the parties' intentions and does not constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, express or implied.

6. Confidentiality

Each Party shall undertake to observe the confidentiality and secrecy of documents, information and other data received from or supplied to the other Party during the period of the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding or any other agreements made pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding.

7. Revision, Modification, and Amendment

Either Party may request in writing a revision, modification or amendment of all or any part of this Memorandum of Understanding within thirty (30) days prior to the mutual negotiation with the other party. Any revision, modification or amendment agreed to by the Parties will be reduced into writing and will form part of this Memorandum of Understanding and come into force on such date as may be determined by the Parties.

8. Termination

Either Party may terminate this MOU by providing written notice of such termination to the other Party within sixty (60) days prior to the date of termination. In the case of such termination, any activities currently underway shall be allowed to continue until their conclusion.

9. Duration

The term of this agreement shall be from the date of signing of the agreement and will remain in effect for five (5) years.

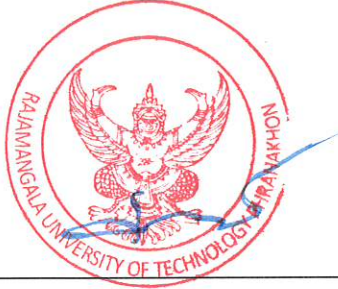
